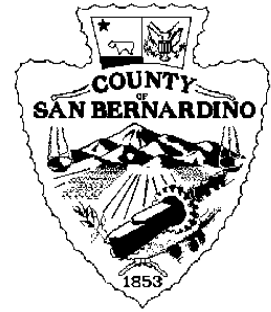

## No-Parking Zone Approved in Crestline

**SAN BERNARDINO** – On Tuesday, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors approved a no-parking zone on Lausanne Drive to improve traffic safety.

The County Department of Public Works studied the intersections of Lausanne and Bernard drives after a resident reported that cars parked on Lausanne Drive blocked drivers' line of site and created a potential public safety hazard. The investigation confirmed the resident's concerns, and Public Works recommended creating a no-parking zone on the west side of Lausanne Drive.

"Residents are a great resource when it comes to identifying potential traffic hazards like this because they drive on these county roads every day," said San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who represents the Crestline area. "I encourage residents to contact my office anytime they see a potential safety issue on a county road."

The Department of Public Works will install no-parking signs on Lausanne Drive in the next few weeks.
