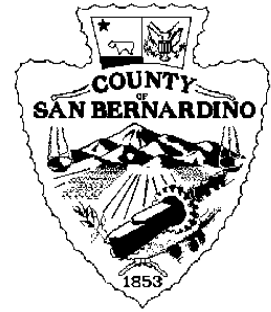

Temporary Road Closure Planned for San Bernardino Avenue

FONTANA – San Bernardino Avenue near Commerce Drive in unincorporated Fontana will be closed for about three days starting Friday to accommodate repairs and safety improvements at a railroad crossing.

The road is scheduled to close at 6 a.m. on Friday and will reopen at noon on Monday. Detour signs will be in place to guide drivers around the closure at the railroad crossing, which is located between Calabash Avenue and Commerce Drive.

“The railroad crossing repairs are the first of many improvements residents will see on San Bernardino Avenue in unincorporated Fontana in the coming months,” San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane said. “The road will also be completely repaved and widened. In addition, landscaped medians will be built to improve driver safety and to beautify the area.”

The improvements on San Bernardino Avenue will occur between Commerce Drive and Cherry Avenue. No further full closures are anticipated for the project. However, drivers should expect lane closures and other minor delays throughout the duration of the construction, which is expected to be completed in June.
